Workshop Overview

This hands-on workshop will introduce participants to the using rubrics to better facilitate teaching and learning. Participants will learn about the four parts that make up a rubric as well as a four step process for developing rubrics. Workshop participants will also be given access to worksheets and templates to help develop their own rubrics. Finally, participants will be introduced to the rubrics feature within WebCT's learning management system.

Outcomes

After attending this workshop participants shall be able to:

- define four parts of a rubric;
- describe a four step method for constructing rubrics;
- construct a three scale/level of performance rubric;\
- locate resources to assist with rubric construction; and
- describe how to use the rubrics function in WebCT.
